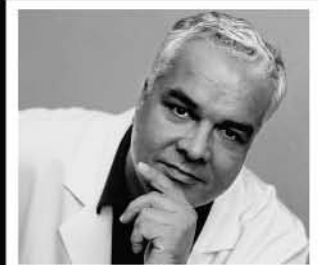
OUTCRY! Stop Nuclear War!
